E107 Summer Music 101 Beginner Percussion - 1:00 - 1:50pm
 Beginner Percussion is for students who have no experience playing percussion. Students will learn basics for snare drum and mallet percussion (xylophone/marimba) playing and how to read basic percussion music notation. All Students should have materials required by their school instrumental music teacher at their first lesson. Students may sign up for any or all of the following weeks: week 1 - July 6th-9th, week 2 - July 12th-16th, week 3 - July 19th-23rd.

E108 Summer Music 102 Beginner Brass - 2:00 - 2:50pm
 Beginner Brass is for students who have no experience playing trumpet, trombone, euphonium/baritone, or french horn. These can be purchased at the music store where you will get the other required materials.  Cost: 3 weeks - \$200, 2 weeks - \$150, 1 week - \$100

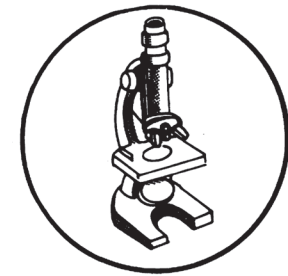
E111 Summer Music 301 Private Instrument Lessons - Three 30-minute lessons

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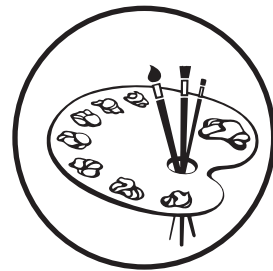
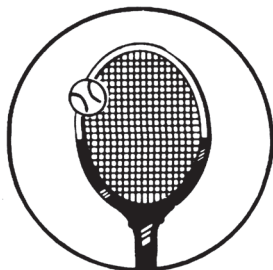

E101. ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUMMER EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT CAMP (Grades Pre-K through 7)

The Emerson Community School is proud to again sponsor our most popular summer program for children. This will be our 39th year providing an exciting, fun-filled and educational program geared to motivate the young learner and stimulate creative thinking during summer vacation. This program features a complete educational enrichment experience every morning (8:45 am - 12:10 pm). Enrollment reflects 2021-2022 grade levels.

This program accentuates the fact that learning is fascinating as well as fun. The program avoids rote and concentrates on learning through brainstorming and the exploration of ideas. Children are encouraged to use their imaginations and to explore their own ideas through a "hands on" philosophy of instruction. The development of higher level thinking and reasoning skills for each child is a goal of the program.

Daily classes for the summer will include:

1) **Computer Workshop** - Learning how to use the computer's basic programs, typing skills, school uses, as well as games, graphics and other creative applications.

2) **Science Investigations** - A variety of science topics will be explored through a "hands on" approach in the high school science laboratory with exposure to science apparatus, equipment, and procedures.

3) **Creative Expressions** - This class concentrates on the development of creative skills. An artistic experience will be the key to this class.

4) **Wellness Training** - This gym class concentrates on cooperative game playing, as well as the development of the fine and gross motor coordination skills. The development of positive inter-personal relationships is emphasized.

5) **Puzzles and Problems** - Children will be challenged as they have fun trying to solve interesting puzzles, answer questions and explore situations aimed at advancing their math thinking skills and increasing their knowledge.

6) **Multimedia Maps** - Explore the world through maps, music, and games. Join us on an exciting geographical adventure to learn about different cultures and places around the world.

Children will be exposed to all of the above classes every day during the program. State certified teachers will be in charge of each class. Student aides will be used to assist staff members as well as children. Grouping will be based on 2021-2022 grade level of the child. (All classrooms are air conditioned, except the gym). **NO CAMP ON 7/5**

Children entering Pre-kindergarten or kindergarten in the fall will be housed in self-contained programs under the direction of certified early childhood educators. They will enjoy many of the same activities listed above, but more appropriate to their young age.

Please note that while course titles are repeated from one summer to the next, course content is always new and different from previous experiences.

*How to Register

The total fee for the morning program is \$450, a \$25 discount is given to the second or third child from any family who attends the morning program. Sign up early as registration is strictly limited due to the necessity of small class size in the program. The program can be pro-rated to \$350 for any three week time period.
