GENERAL INFORMATION

Career and Continuing Education

Career and Continuing Education Courses are designed for adults who want to learn a trade or supplement the skills and technical knowledge they use in their present jobs. Serious hobbyists are welcome, too. Students in the Career and Continuing Education Program learn by doing. Classes are held in the Monmouth County Vocational School District's fully equipped shops and classrooms using modern tools, equipment and techniques. Shop work is supplemented by the instruction in theory and principles of the trade. Instructors are teachers in the Monmouth County Vocational School District Day Program and other highly skilled, experienced trades people. No course credits are given in the Career and Continuing Education Program; however, each student with proper attendance is given a certificate, which indicates the number of hours attended.

Admission Requirements

Adult vocational education classes are open to all persons 16 years of age or older (unless otherwise noted) who have graduated or left an elementary or secondary school system. Additional course requirements are listed as prerequisites. ESL Manicuring and Nail Technology

This 300-hour course is offered to high school graduates and meets the requirements for licensing examination given by the State Board of Hairstyling and Cosmetology. This course prepares graduates to work in the field of nail technology. Students who complete this program and wish to further their career in cosmetology may transfer up to 150 hours to the regular cosmetology program. Course is paid in two installments. Manicuring will consist of a combination of in person classes as well as independent study to achieve the required 300 hours state board requirements. The Manicuring class will consist of basic manicuring and pedicuring techniques as well as instruction on gel polish, hard gels, acrylics, nail wraps and

waxing. State board prep, general sciences, nail care and business skills will be covered in addition. A copy of your High School Diploma or GED is required at start of the class. Students must purchase a uniform.

that incorporate the GED test, which will be

ESL Certified Nurse Aide Class (CNA)

This program is designed for those whose native language is not English, who understand a moderate amount of English, and who wish to enter the field of nursing. Students will be given the tools to improve their speaking, reading, and writing skills while they attend the Certified Nurse Aide in a Long Term Care Facility (CNA) course. Students will develop the skills necessary to care competently for the predominately geriatric client. Upon successful completion of the go-hour course (50 hours classroom and 40 hours clinical), students will be eligible to take the New Jersey State Nurse Aide in Long Term Care Facility Exam. Students can be absent no more than two classes. Additional hours may be required for those students who need extra help. **According** to the New Jersey Department of Health, CNA candidates do not need a high school diploma to become licensed, however, a prerequisite for certification is passing criminal background check and other documentation as noted on the NJ Department of Health website. Students

must bring copy of picture ID and ss# or Tax ID to first class. Admission requirements: complete physical examination including flu/ Covid-19 vaccine, background check, purchase uniform and attend orientation. Cost of certification exam is not included. Students are responsible for their own PPE.

Microsoft Excel: Advanced

Microsoft Excel training for business professionals shows you advanced Excel skills that apply to creating smart adaptive Excel business tools.

Our advanced Excel training focuses on: Creating Excel analysis and data processing tools using advanced formulas, array formulas, logic, ActiveX controls, conditional formatting, data validation, pivot tables, pivot charts, Excel tables and relationships.

Advanced aspects of these elements and how to assemble them in sophisticated ways including modeling and creating interactive dashboards will be covered. Creation of advanced logic will be reviewed, which allows these tools to operate autonomously and adapt to changing data. We will also provide an introduction to macros (VBA).

TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGY



Pilot Ground School

Ever dreamed of piloting a private plane? This course, taught by a FAA certified flight instructor, is an introduction to the requirements of becoming a private pilot certified for fixed wing (not helicopter) single engine aircraft. Topics include Principles of Flight and Aerodynamics, Aviation Physiology, Airports and Air Traffic Control, Aircraft Engines, Instruments, Systems and Performance, Weather, Navigation, Flight Planning, and FAA Regulations. Students shall be responsible for purchasing their own materials (approximately \$75). This course will prepare students with the necessary aeronautical knowledge that can be used to pass the FAA private pilot written exam.

(FLIGHT INSTRUCTION IN AN AIRCRAFT NOT INCLUDED). This is also an excellent refresher course for current and non-current rated private, recreational and sport pilots. The course is also open to non-pilot aviation enthusiasts.

Automotive Technician (Beginners)

Students interested in pursuing the automotive trade as a career will receive hands-on and classroom training for entry level employment addressing the following: tools, precision measuring equipment, shop procedures and safety.

Basic automotive systems such as engine fundamentals, power train service, brakes, tires, exhaust systems, suspension, and alignment procedures will be covered.

Advanced automotive technology including engine computer controls, anti-skid braking systems, air conditioning, fuel and air management systems will be included to prepare the student for entry into a modern automotive service facility.

TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGY



Automotive Technician and ASE Course Hands-on & Theory

This expanded version of the Beginner course, designed to help individuals launch or level up their careers in the automotive industry. Over the course of 144 hours, students will gain a solid foundation in automotive theory, explore real-world scenarios, and engage in hands-on applications. Instructional topics include: Engine components, General Maintenance, Cooling systems, Brakes, Steering and suspension, Wheel alignments, Driveline systems, Starting and charging systems. The course also includes preparation for ASE certification tests in the following areas: A1: Engine Repair A4: Steering and Suspension A5: Brakes

Whether you're a dedicated DIYer or just starting your career, this program is here to provide you with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to succeed in the automotive field. Supply list (minimal) and book information will be sent to students upon registration. Students should provide their own vehicle for demonstration purposes, which would be subject to instructor approval.

ASE Certified Technician Test Prep Course (Theory Only)

Becoming an ASE Certified Technician? This ASE test prep course will build your test-taking skills and utilize the most up-to-date test information and resources.

Technicians with ASE credentials help instill customer confidence. The instructor, a Master Automotive Technician, will individualize your ASE PREP instruction.

This course will focus on the following areas: Suspension and Steering, Brakes, Electrical/ Electronic Systems and Engine Performance. This course will prepare students for the A1 through A8 ASE exams. Textbook and cost of exam not included.

Tractor Trailer - CDL Class A

In partnership with Superior Driving School in Toms River, students will prepare for all written C.D.L. exams including: General Knowledge, Air Brakes, Combination Vehicles, Hazmat, Tankers, Doubles & Triples.

The theory portion of the course will take place in the Neptune Annex. Upon completion of the theory portion of the class, the students are required to take and pass the written CDL Class A exam at a NJ Motor Vehicle Agency before they can continue their training. The mandatory yard and road portion of the class will take place at 2834 Lacey Road, Forked River, NJ at the Superior Driving School location. The yard and road training will cover all skills necessary to pass the new federally regulated road test at NJ Motor Vehicles. Upon completing this training, students will be required to take a road test at NJ Motor Vehicle testing center coordinated by Superior Driving School.

The total cost of the course is \$4,250. A mandatory deposit of \$220 is required to Superior Driving School upon registration as well as a payment In the amount of \$280 to MCVSD.

CDL School Bus/Bus with Passenger Endorsement

In partnership with Superior Driving School in Toms River, students will prepare for all written C.D.L. exams including: General Knowledge, Air Brakes, Hazmat, Tankers and Passenger. The theory portion of the course will take place in the Neptune Annex. Upon completion of the theory portion of the class, the students are required to take and pass the written CDL Class B exam at a NJ Motor Vehicle Agency before they can continue their training. The mandatory yard and road portion of the class will take place at 2834 Lacey Road, Forked River, NJ at the Superior Driving School location. The yard and road training will cover all skills necessary to pass the new federally regulated road test at NJ Motor Vehicles.

Upon completing this training, students will be required to take a road test at NJ Motor Vehicle testing center coordinated by Superior Driving School. Upon completion of this course Drivers will be able to drive Automatic transmission class B vehicles including Busses. Please note that this training will NOT enable a driver to operate a School Bus. There is a separate endorsement, "S" (School Bus) which is required (not included in this course) and can be obtained after receiving the "P" (Passenger) endorsement, included in this course.

The total cost of the course is \$2,750. A mandatory deposit of \$220 is required to Superior Driving School upon registration as well as a payment in the amount of \$280.00 to MCVSD.

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY



Boiler Operator Low Pressure: BLACK SEAL - ONLINE COURSE

This course prepares qualified and experienced persons responsible for the operation of public and private buildings for state licensing as required by law. You must be working in the field in order to take this class. Instruction covers functions of low-pressure boilers and their safe operation; air pollution control and energy conservation. Books, supplies and personal safety equipment not included in tuition.

Introduction to Instrumentation and Control Fundamentals

This course will cover the field of industrial maintenance.

- Apply fundamental techniques of final control devices
- Use and maintain instrumentation documentation





Welding Apprenticeship

The Welding Apprenticeship program is designed to provide classroom instruction with intro practical hands-on. This is an entry-level welding program designed to help students obtain a career in the welding industry. The students will be welding in booths completing multiple weld coupons in various configurations. Introduction to Water and Wastewater Operation Apprenticeship

The first half of this course covers the mathematics and science needed. For water/wastewater operation. Topics include mathematical operations, algebra, geometry, and physics as applied to hydraulics, electricity, chemistry, and microbiology. The second half addresses water distribution and treatment. Satisfactory completion of IWW101 (180 hours), one year of on-the-job experience and a high school diploma are the NJ state requirements for the W-1, S-1, C-1, and T-1 level Water and Wastewater Operation Licensing. Per NJ Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) regulations, those seeking a Level 1 "S" (wastewater treatment) or "C" (wastewater collection system) license must successfully complete an approved "Introduction to Wastewater" course. This course is designed to familiarize attendees with the skills required for employment as a wastewater treatment or collection system operator and to introduce them to the various equipment and processes routinely used in these facilities such as pumps, valves, tanks, activated sludge, compressors, blowers, chemical feed systems, etc.

Instructors will discuss the physical, mechanical, chemical, and biological processes involved in collecting and treating municipal wastewater. The course will reinforce required math skills and discuss basic chemistry, physics, microbiology, and hydraulics. Reading assignments for each class date will be taken from the NJDEP required textbooks published by the California State University at Sacramento. Regularly scheduled tests and quizzes are included in the agenda as well as remote assignments. Cost of textbook not included in tuition.

This 45-hour class will prepare you for a Level 2 or higher NJ "C" wastewater collection system license exam.



HEALTH SCIENCE NURSING

Practical Nursing Program (LPN)

Starting in 1958, the MCVSD Practical Nursing Program has graduated over 4,100 students. For the past five years in a row the Nursing Licensure Examination (NCLEX) pass rate has remained at 100%. This course offers academic studies and clinical experience to prepare students to meet the state requirements for licensure as a practical nurse in New Jersey. It is approved by the New Jersey State Board of Nursing and the New Jersey Department of Education and accredited by Middle States. Graduates are eligible to take the NCLEX in New Jersey. Each class is assigned to an affiliating hospital/nursing home for clinical experience.

Tuition is \$13,000 payable in four payments. Financial aid and grants are available for qualifying applicants. Approved by the Department of Education for veterans benefits and the Monmouth County Division of Employment & Training. Refunds will be honored based on board policy. For more information go to www.mcvsd. org and click "Practical Nursing."

Applicants must be 18 years of age upon entering the program, must have a high school diploma or the equivalent, and pass a qualifying test. After passing the qualifying test the applicant must pay a \$100 non-refundable registration fee. The ATI TEAS entrance test can be taken remotely by contacting the Brookdale Community College Testing Center. Not included in fees: a complete physical examination, a criminal background check, textbooks, CPR certification, and other COVID-19 clinical site requirements.

Clinical sites require students to have up-todate vaccinations including the Flu and current COVID-19 vaccinations.

LPN Refresher

The Licensed Practical Nurse Refresher curriculum provides a refresher course for individuals previously licensed as Practical Nurses and who are ineligible for reentry into nursing practice due to a lapse in licensure for five or more years. Course work includes common medical-surgical conditions and nursing approaches to their management, including bedside patient care infection control practices, and medication administration. 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


Manicuring and Nail Technology

Manicuring will consist of a combination of in person classes as well as independent study to achieve the required 300 hours state board requirements. The Manicuring class will consist of basic manicuring and pedicuring techniques as

well as instruction on gel polish, hard gels, acrylics, nail wraps and waxing. State board prep, general sciences, nail care and business skills will be covered in addition. 
