TCA College Pathways (CP) Dance Guest Form

- TCA CP students are allowed **ONE** guest. Any person not currently enrolled at TCA CP, including TCA North students, is considered a guest.
- Guests must **check-in** and depart with their sponsoring TCA CP student. CP students bringing a guest may not enter the dance until their guest arrives.
- Guests are required to present an ID (student ID, driver's license, etc.) at the ticket table for check-in.
- **You may not bring a guest who is younger than 9th grade, a guest who is 21 or over, or a guest who has graduated from college.**
- The sponsoring TCA CP parent/guardian accepts responsibility for the guest's behavior at the event.
- This completed form must be returned to Tami Saldana by **12:00 PM (noon) the day before the event** so that guest lists can be prepared.
- Incomplete forms cannot be processed; guests turning in an incomplete form will not be admitted.

College Pathways Winter Formal Dress Guidelines

General Dress Guidelines -

1. No jeans or shorts
2. Collared shirt and tie are appropriate
3. Sports coats/suits are optional

Dresses

- Dresses must come down to at least the middle of the thigh after movement (walking/dancing) is factored in.
- There should be no visible cleavage or plunging necklines.
- Dresses may contain no cut-outs.
- Dresses must have at least the lower half of the back covered.
- Excessively tight or body-con dresses will not be allowed.
- No more than 2” of midriff may be visible.
- Dresses with a slit that extend higher than the approved length of the dress are not allowed.
- Body suits or other inappropriate clothing will not be allowed.

If your student is bringing a guest from another school, please remind them of our expectations. Most of our students dress appropriately, and I thank you for your support in this area.
